

Madera Reading Club Introduction

Welcome everyone to the Madera Reading Club of the school year 2018/2019!
The Reading Club is designed to encourage a love for reading. All students are welcome to participate but it is completely voluntary.

The Basics:

Blank reading logs go home via Blue Folders each month September through May. If you need extras they can be found in the front office or find the file on the website.

For each 20 minutes read you cross out (or color if you want) one book.

There will be no online reading logs this year.

At the end of the month (or the beginning of the new) hand in the log to your teacher or drop them off in the front office in the Reading Club box (whatever your teacher prefers).

Pick up a book and read! If you can't read yourself yet, read with your parents, grandparents or a friend.

Things to fill out:

- Your name
- Your teacher's name
- Month submitted
- Number of books you crossed out (or colored) at the end of the month
- One book you really liked this month (book title, author and your grade)
- Get your parents to sign the log

What do I get?

Each month will feature a different button designed by students and for each month you submit a log you will get the button. For the 1st submitted log you will also receive a book mark and at the end of the school year you can pick a book to take home.

If you reached 600 minutes read total someone will come by your classroom and take your picture. A magnet with your picture will be displayed in the Reading Club display case, just outside of the office until the end of the school year. Photo permission is assumed to be yes, unless I'm notified. At the end of the school year you get to take the magnet home as well.
